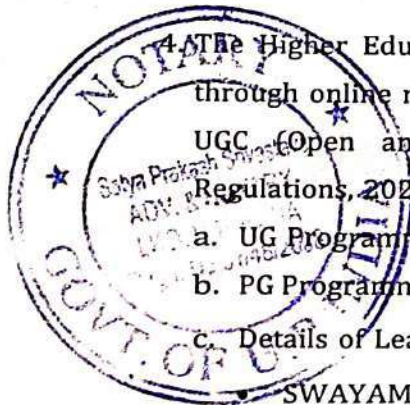

14. That the Higher Educational Institution ensures to conduct proctored examinations with all the security arrangements ensuring transparency and credibility of the examinations.

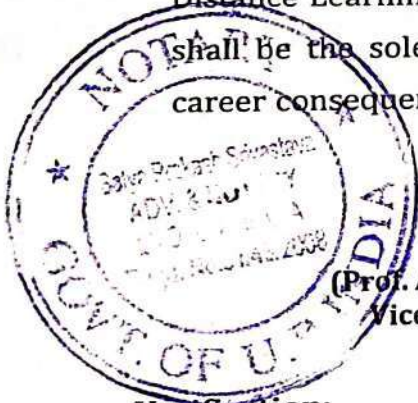
